4. Monthly Airport Director's Comments - John Martin, SFO Airport Director

- Passenger traffic continues to grow even though flight operations are down
- The passenger trend indicates Airlines are using larger aircraft and are experiencing higher load factors
- The Airport recently conducted an Aircraft Emergency Tri-Annual Drill
- The Noise Office recently completed a 30-day full acceptance test of the new Noise Monitoring System
- Since October 21, 2005 SOIA/PRM has been used a total of 34 days

5. Noise Complaint "Hot Spot" Map

- The Noise Complaint "Hot Spot" Map was created at the request of the Work Program Subcommittee
- The "Hot Spot" map shows the complaints received by the SFO Noise Office over the period of one year
- The number of complainants dropped from 369 in 2003 to 339 in 2004
- The shift of "Hot Spots" from 2003 to 2004 indicates that different groups of people are calling
- Aircraft tracks do not necessarily correlate with received noise complaints
