7. Monthly Airport Director's Report

Comments / Concerns / Questions:

- Welcome to all new representatives your participation is appreciated
- SFO has experienced a 1% increase in traffic overall for 2006
- There has been a 4% increase in international traffic in 2006 but SFO traffic is still approximately 20% below the peak traffic levels experienced in 1999-2000
- A slight increase in traffic is expected over the summer with the addition of jetBlue flights
- The SOIA / PRM Approach to Runways 28 has been in operation for over two years and was used four (4) times over the last week
- The efforts of the Noise Abatement Office Staff have been successful and the SOIA / PRM minimum altitude should be reduced to 1600 feet in the near future
- The Airport has received funds from the FAA for Phase II of the Noise Monitoring System and is currently finalizing the contract extension with the vendor
- Phase II will include a Ground Run-up Detection System and software upgrades that will allow the Noise Office Staff to determine more specific noise impact areas
- The new equipment will improve the Airport's ability to monitor low-frequency noise
- The system will allow for both A and C weighted noise to be measured
- A-weighted noise is the higher frequency noise or the whistle / whine type noise
- C-weighted noise is the lower frequency noise or the base / thump/vibration type noise
- The process of reinstating the noise monitor in the City of Pacifica is progressing and should result in a monitor being up and running shortly
- Virgin America has submitted an amended application specifically addressing the concerns brought forth by the Department of Transportation
- Virgin America could hear a decision as soon as the end of February but it is more likely that they will hear the decision toward the middle of April regarding federal approval to begin scheduled service

b. Jon C. Long Fly Quiet Program Quarterly Report - 4th Quarter 2006

Comments / Concerns / Questions:

Bert Ganoung, Airport Noise Abatement Manager, reported the following:

- SFO average Fleet Noise Quality was down 0.2 from last quarter at 4.65
- The decrease in the Fleet Noise Quality ratings was due some airlines bringing in more MD-80 aircraft and some cargo operators brining in the louder 474-200 aircraft
- The SFO average Noise Exceedance rating was down 0.3 from last quarter at 8.41
- The SFO average Nighttime Preferential Runway Use rating is up significantly from 4.02 to 5.69
- Weather is the biggest factor for the increase in Nighttime Preferential Runway Use scores
- The SFO average Shoreline Departure Rating is down 0.6 from last quarter
- The SFO average Gap Departure rating has improved over last quarter from 5.08 to 5.85

c. Status Report from the Roundtable Media Program Subcommittee, re: Media Program Elements

Dave Carbone, Roundtable coordinator, reported the following:

- The Subcommittee met for the second time last week
- The Subcommittee was implemented to reactivate our media program
- Russ Cohen has replaced Terry Nagel as the Representative from Burlingame on the Subcommittee
- The goal of the Roundtable Media Program is to enhance the Roundtables outreach and education of the community regarding the Roundtable's partnership with the Airport and our joint effort to mitigate noise related to aircraft operations at San

Francisco International Airport in affected communities and neighborhoods

- There are several components to the Roundtable Media Program including: 1) community and media outreach via an electronic quarterly newsletter and up to six, (6) press releases per year, 2) enhancement of the Roundtable website to improve the utility of the site and offer more information to site users, 3) update Roundtable logo via a logo contest, 4) develop a Roundtable tagline that would capture the essence of the Roundtable and what we do
- The Subcommittee has tasked the Roundtable staff with putting together an RFP (Request for Proposal) to obtain a consultant(s) to assist with writing the e-newsletter and related press releases
- Once finalized the Subcommittee will present the Media Program to the Roundtable for final approval
