





• Completion of the Second Chance Initiative (SCI 2022-2026 Phase):

- ✓ Total budget: \$3.0 million (\$2.4 million FAA grant; \$600K SFO funds)
- ✓ Scope: Insulation of approximately 19 eligible homes that have never been treated (SEE NOTE BELOW).
- ✓ Pre-construction acoustical tests to determine eligibility: Completed on 11/29/2022
- ✓ Expect completion of design plans/specs by mid-2023

• <u>Re-insulation of Residential Properties insulated before 1993 (Pre-19993 2022-2026 Phase):</u>

- \checkmark New initiative started by the FAA in FFY2022
- ✓ Total budget: \$12 million (\$9.6 million FAA grant, \$2.4 million SFO funds)
- ✓ Scope: Replacement insulation of 80-90 eligible homes previously insulated before 1993 (SEE NOTE BELOW)
- ✓ Total potentially eligible properties identified for this Phase: 121
- ✓ Total responses received: 113
- ✓ Number of properties whose eligibility has been confirmed: 94


NOTE: POTENTIALLY ELIGIBLE PROPERTIES ARE SUBJECT TO SITE INSPECTIONS AND ACOUSTICAL TESTS TO DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY. ONLY PROPERTIES WITH AVERAGE INTERIOR NOISE LEVEL GREATER THAN 45dB AND MEETING ALL OTHER FAA ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS CAN RECEIVE ACOUSTIC TREATMENT.
